Solid Foundations

Current Center health services provide essential care daily, but limited space and diagnostics force routine issues off-site, triggering EMS calls.

Strong Building Blocks

The on-site clinic will deliver primary, preventive, dental, diagnostic, and behavioral health services—including immunizations, well-checks, chronic-care support, X-ray, and dental care—on campus. Centralizing care removes access barriers, strengthens family wellness, and could cut avoidable ER and emergency calls by up to 50%.



Lasting Impacts

Through trusted referrals, The Coalition supports women and families’ health—even without an on-site clinic. Margaret, nearly deaf, received hearing aids through our coordination, restoring connection and daily life. A dedicated campus Health Clinic would expand proactive, comprehensive care.
