Solid Foundations

The Coalition currently provides three meals per day to our guests along with one meal per day open to any unhoused individuals in the community needing a hot meal. This equates to approximately 230,000 meals annually, prepared and served out of the kitchen and dining hall of our Men's Service Center.

Strong Building Blocks

The inclusion of a commercial kitchen in the new Center for Women and Families will allow The Coalition to scale meal production to approximately 335,000 meals annually. Additionally, the new dining hall will allow women, children, and families a more private, safe space to enjoy a hot meal together while having conversations with other guests or having a family chat about the day's activities.

Lasting Impact

Healthy, nutritious meals are crucial in helping to navigate the day-to-day activities and stressors that come with work, school, and life in general. Reliable nutrition fuels children and adults through the most demanding phase of transition while addressing food insecurity across the community.
