Summertime reminds us of something so special about the Coalition—our outdoor spaces where guests relax after a long day at work, kids play after school, and connection happens. Our current Center for Women and Families offers 2 playgrounds for children, as well as a space of picnic tables where families and friends gather, allowing for our campus to truly feel like a community.

Strong Building Blocks

The new building will provide space to bring this connection and outside play to the next level! Guests will have access to a courtyard accented by murals done by members of our neighborhood, an outdoor courtyard with frequent community events, a youth recreational field and garden area, a youth sport court, and an upgraded and expanded playground in direct sightlines of classrooms. These spaces will reinforce school attendance, improve physical health, and give families space to grow in the midst of their transition back to permanent housing.
