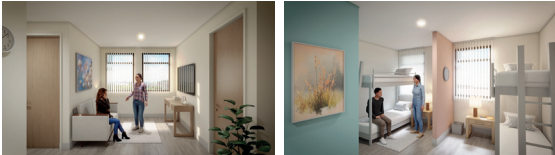
Upcoming Milestones

Solid Foundations

The Coalition exists to help provide a pathway to stable housing for the men, women, and children in our community who are experiencing homelessness. Last year, we were able to help approximately 2,500 find stable housing through services such as diversion to family members, rental assistance, Rapid Rehousing and more. The need is great, but The Coalition continues to rise to meet that need!

Strong Building Blocks



With the addition of more space and the expansion or creation of crucial services that the new Center for Women and Families will provide, The Coalition should be able to increase the number of men, women, and children we successfully help place in permanent housing by 40+%. This represents about 1,100 additional people, for a total of approximately 3,600, we will be able to assist in avoiding or escaping the crisis of homelessness!
